LAKE LILLINONAH AUTHORITY REGULAR MEETING
BROOKFIELD TOWN HALL – ROOM 227
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2012
7:30PM**

CALL TO ORDER: B. Boodry began the meeting at 7:30pm.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion was made by S. Young, seconded by S. Bot, to approve the Lake Lillinonah Authority Regular Meeting Minutes of August 7, 2012 as written. The motion was passed unanimously.

INTRODUCTION OF GUESTS: There were no guests present at this month's meeting.

CORRESPONDENCE: There was no communication received since the last Lake Lillinonah Regular Meeting on August 7, 2012.

OFFICER REPORTS:

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: B. Boodry stated that he received several complaints with regard to the weed issue in the lake. B. Boodry stated that the FL&P will draw down the lake from November 3-11, 2012.

VICE CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: G. Petriccione stated that he and S. Young were out on the lake to mark the points for the wood debris tour.

SECOND VICE CHAIRMAN'S REPORT: S. Young stated that he received a thank you letter from Leaps of Faith. S. Young reported the Marine Patrol update for the month of August 2012.

TREASURER'S REPORT: L. Leaden was not present for this meeting to give her Treasurer's report.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Preliminary Budget Discussion:** B. Boodry stated that the budget process will begin shortly. He also stated that next month each member will receive a budget spreadsheet for the past two years. He asked all members to think about any items that they would like added, changed, or deleted from the budget for discussion during the next two months. B. Piepho stated that he would like to see a budget increase for fish stocking of Northern Pike and Large Mouth Bass. Another suggestion was to invest in weed mats. The budget will be sent to the area towns in December 2012.
